Workshop Description

This off-site workshop will focus on helping librarians to understand and use ethnographic research methods--long used for cultural anthropology research--to better understand their libraries, their users, and how their services and collections are used.

<u>Lynne Silipigni Connaway, Senior Research Scientist and Director of User Research at OCLC</u> will present the **keynote** "Capturing the behaviors of the Elusive User: Strategies for Library Ethnography."

<u>Celia Emmelheinz</u>, Anthropology and Qualitative Research Librarian at UC Berkeley will lead the workshop.

Through interactive/hands-on activities, the workshop participants will explore an "ethnographic toolkit" they can use to better understand the context in which their users engage with their library and its resources. Topics covered include learning how to ask good research questions; honing participation and observation skills; engaging patrons in research through mapping and diaries; coding and interpreting findings, and using results to spark deeper engagement with the user community.
