



First steps in Primo: **electronic resources**



Besides the traditional (printed) resources, the University Library also has access to foreign databases of complete texts. They mainly consist of scientific articles, but they include books as well.

The biggest and most popular databases are:

- EBSCO 
- ProQuest 



Electronic resources from various sources are indexed in Primo.

LICENSED RESOURCES

Only users with an e-mail address in the UoW Internet domain (@uwr.edu.pl) can access them. You need to sign in to your library account.

OPEN ACCESS RESOURCES

Anyone can access them with no account required.

To search for electronic resources, you need to select the **All UoW resources** search scope.

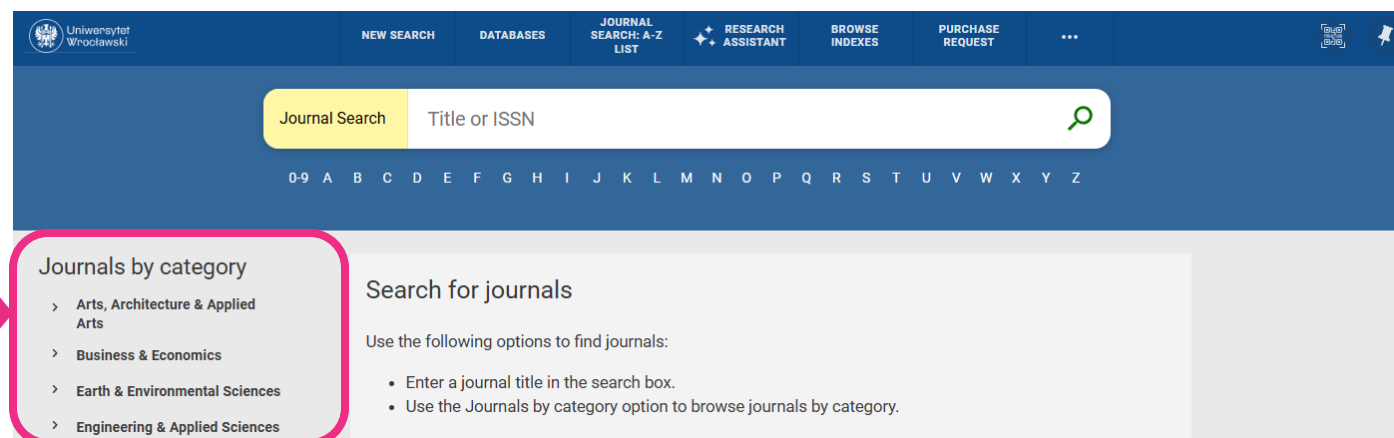

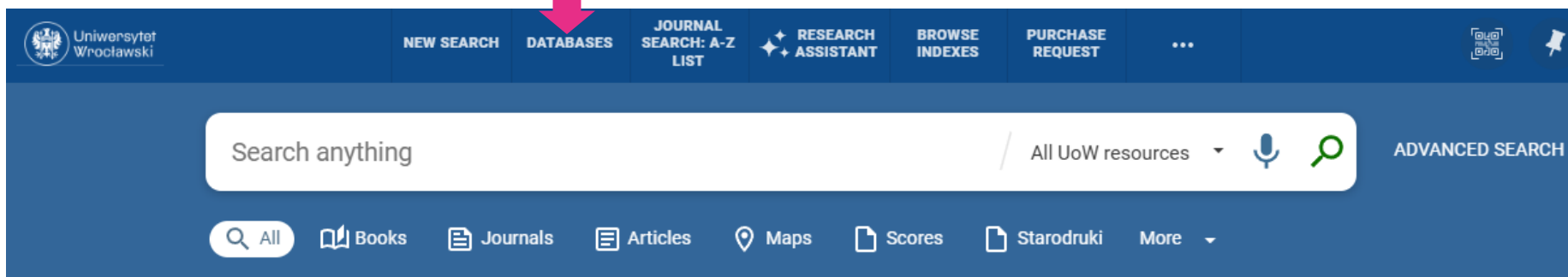

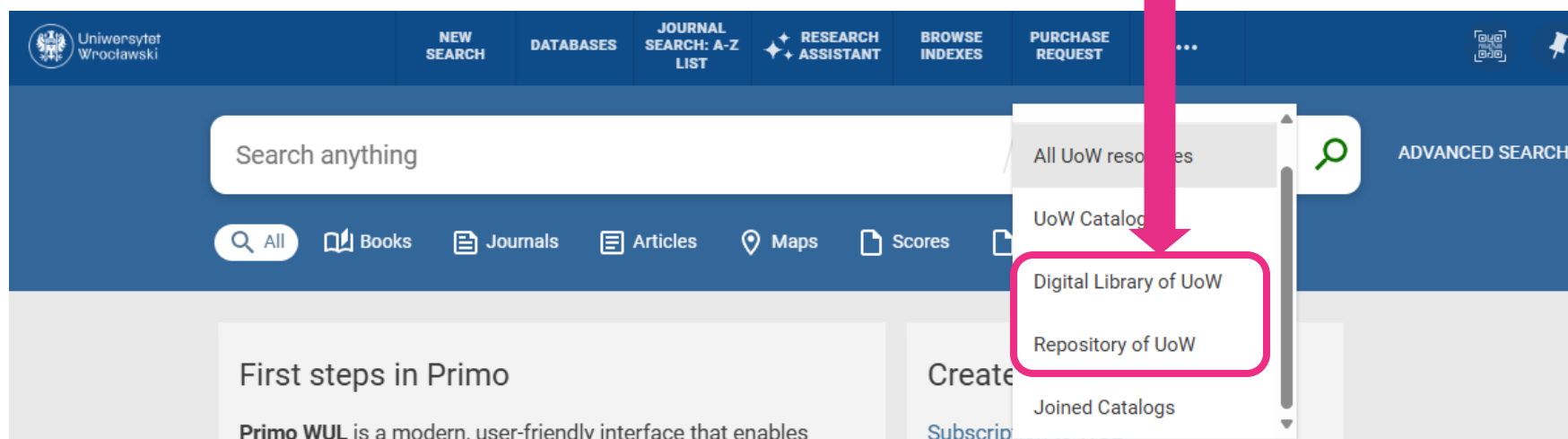
Open Access - to wolny, bezpłatny, ale także powszechny, trwały i szybki dostęp do publikacji elektronicznych o treściach naukowych i edukacyjnych. Każdy użytkownik sieci ma prawo czytać, kopiować, drukować, rozpowszechniać, indeksować, cytować i przeszukiwać zasoby otwarte, w tym pełne teksty artykułów, raportów z badań, materiałów konferencyjnych, wykładów akademickich i książek opublikowanych w modelu Open Access. Użytkownik korzysta z materiałów bez ograniczeń finansowych, prawnych i technicznych, przy zachowaniu praw autorskich.

Digital Library of the University of Wrocław

In the Digital Library, there are **digitized collections** of great historical and cultural significance, including **books, journals, manuscripts, old prints, photographs, scores, maps, and other materials**. The collections relate to the heritage of the European and regional culture, especially the Lower Silesia and Wrocław. **The collections are available online 24/7, though some of them can be used only in the Wrocław University Library due to copyrights.**

Repository of the University of Wrocław

In the Repository, we gather and share scientific, research, and developmental works created by the staff, doctoral students, and other selected students of the University of Wrocław. It contains **selected doctoral theses, postdoctoral theses (habilitacje), MA theses, BA theses, scientific articles, conference materials, monographs, and grey literature (e.g. reports).**
