Declaration of the legal guardian of a minor

and I consent to the above-mentioned person using the services of the Wrocław University Library and other libraries included in the library and information system of the University of Wrocław on-site in reading rooms and in Free Access areas.

I declare that I have read the *Rules of library's materials circulation in the library and information system of the University of Wrocław* and undertake to comply with them by a minor. I acknowledge that, as their legal guardian, I am responsible for all actions of minors in the libraries, including the loss or destruction of library materials.

Information Clause (GDPR)

In the case of collecting data directly from the data subject pursuant to Article 13 paragraphs 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter "GDPR"):

1. The administrator of your personal data is the University of Wrocław, Uniwersytecki 1 Sqr., 50-137 Wrocław.
2. The Personal Data Protection Officer can be contacted via e-mail: IOD@uwr.edu.pl or by telephone: +48 71 375 26 04.
3. Personal data are processed to provide minors with access to the collections and services of the Wrocław University Library and other libraries within the library and information system of the University of Wrocław. The data is necessary for: verifying the legal

guardian's identity (confirming that the person signing the declaration has the right to represent the minor), identifying the minor (enabling libraries to assign responsibility for the use of library services), contacting the legal guardian (if clarification is needed regarding the use of library services), and consenting to the processing of the minor's personal data (in accordance with GDPR regulations, the consent of a legal guardian is required for the processing of a child's data).

4. The basis for data processing is: Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR (legal obligation of a parent/legal guardian to represent a minor resulting from the provisions of the Family Code as fulfillment of a legal obligation incumbent on the administrator), Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR (performance of a task carried out in the public interest)
5. Providing personal data is voluntary, however, failure to provide it will prevent a minor from using library services.
6. Personal data will be stored for the period of use of library services and for the period necessary to pursue or defend claims, in accordance with legal provisions.
7. The recipients of data may be entities authorized under the provisions of law and entities providing services to the University of Wrocław on the basis of concluded data processing agreements.
8. Personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subject to profiling.
9. The data subject has the right to: access the data, rectify it, limit its processing, and lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office. Contact details are available on the website: <https://uodo.gov.pl>.
