### Information clause (GDPR)

In accordance with Article 13 paragraphs 1 and 2 and Article 14 paragraphs 1 and 2 of  
Regulation (EU) No 16/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016

3. The data of the authorized representative are processed on the basis of Article 6 paragraph

4. Data may be transferred to entities processing them on behalf of the University of  
Wrocław, in accordance with applicable law, to authorized employees, entities and bodies  
that have the right to do so under the provisions of generally applicable law.
5. You have the right to access the content of your data, correct it, limit its usage, and  
process them.
6. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the provision of library services.
7. Personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subject to  
profiling.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection  
Office (UODO) if your data is processed in violation of applicable regulations. Contact
